2. A very significant improvement in fuchsia condition and fuchsia canopy density and an associated reduction in the proportion of dieback in fuchsia. The prolonged reduction in possum density following the ground-based poisoning in 2008 and the ongoing trapping programme are likely to be the major factors in this improvement.
